Average % of time spent in each area

I. Training employees at all levels –20% of time.

Could be class room, on the job, or one-on-one.

Initially or specific business needs could move the % of time spent up or down.

Job Description/Duties:

- Weekly preparation for training, scheduling of time, etc.
- Time with the field employee, balanced between the number of employees and activity demand.
- Meet in office at beginning of day/job
- At the job sites for compliance review, hazard analysis, & training.
- End of day, back to office for review and follow-up with management
- Contract/bid job site inspection with salesman/estimator at bid time.
- Contract/bid job site compliance follow-up.
- Prepare Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) for on-going work and specific work with appropriate personnel.
- Design; determine safe practices to protect from JHA issues identified.
- New hire orientation and training when available – this is primarily a division managers responsibility.
- Provide specific equipment and/or certification training and awareness.
- Forklift, aerial lift, respirator, lead exposure, etc.
- Confined space, fall protection, excavation, etc.

Requirements (tangible & intangible):

- Persistent
- Mature, good morals & ethics
- Ambition, drive to be successful, possibility thinker
- Good work ethics, stable, vigorous physical health, vigorous mental health
- Trainable, desire to learn, great attitude
- Successful track record in the field of safety and loss control

- People skills and sensitivity. Can relate to all levels of employees and “sell” them on working safely.
- Good verbal and written communication skills

Additional Skills:

- Forklift, aerial lift, respirator, lead exposure, etc.
- Confined space, fall protection, excavation, etc.
- OSHA 10 and 30 hour training
- Rigging and cranes
- (Certain ‘must haves’ could be gained via training within 6 to 12 months)
